## Observation Unit

### Hemochron whole blood coagulation system

The Hemochron is a machine that helps nurses know the potential for bleeding in a patient post-cardiac catheterization. It indicates when large catheters can safely be removed from veins and arteries.

## Fitness

### Cardiovascular equipment

An arm ergometer provides a cardiovascular workout using upper body only while seated or standing. It is also wheelchair accessible.

The five current ellipticals are getting older and need replacing. Five new Precor Elliptical trainers are desired.

## Heart & Vascular Services

### EkoSonic endovascular system

This system delivers drugs to vessel blockages via a flexible catheter that is passed through the artery. Combined with MicroSonic technology, clots in the artery are safely and effectively dissolved, improving blood circulation in the patient.

**\$20,000 total**

### AngioJet ultra thrombectomy system

The AngioJet system sends out pulsatile waves that break up plaque in blood vessels. It then extracts the plaque to restore blood flow to blocked veins and arteries.

**\$25,000 total**

### Ultrasound table for stress test room

This table is specially designed to position patients in the correct scanning posture to prevent musculoskeletal injury to technicians. The cardiac scanning cutout provides open access to patients' left chest area for an unobstructed view of the heart.

**\$7,000.....(1 needed)**

### New treadmill stress test machine

The current stress test treadmill in Cardiac Noninvasive Diagnostic Testing is getting older and frequently needs repairs. A new treadmill would improve the quality and efficiency of cardiac stress tests and stress echos. These tests require patients to run on the treadmill while technicians monitor and observe the effect of exercise on the heart.

### Night stands
